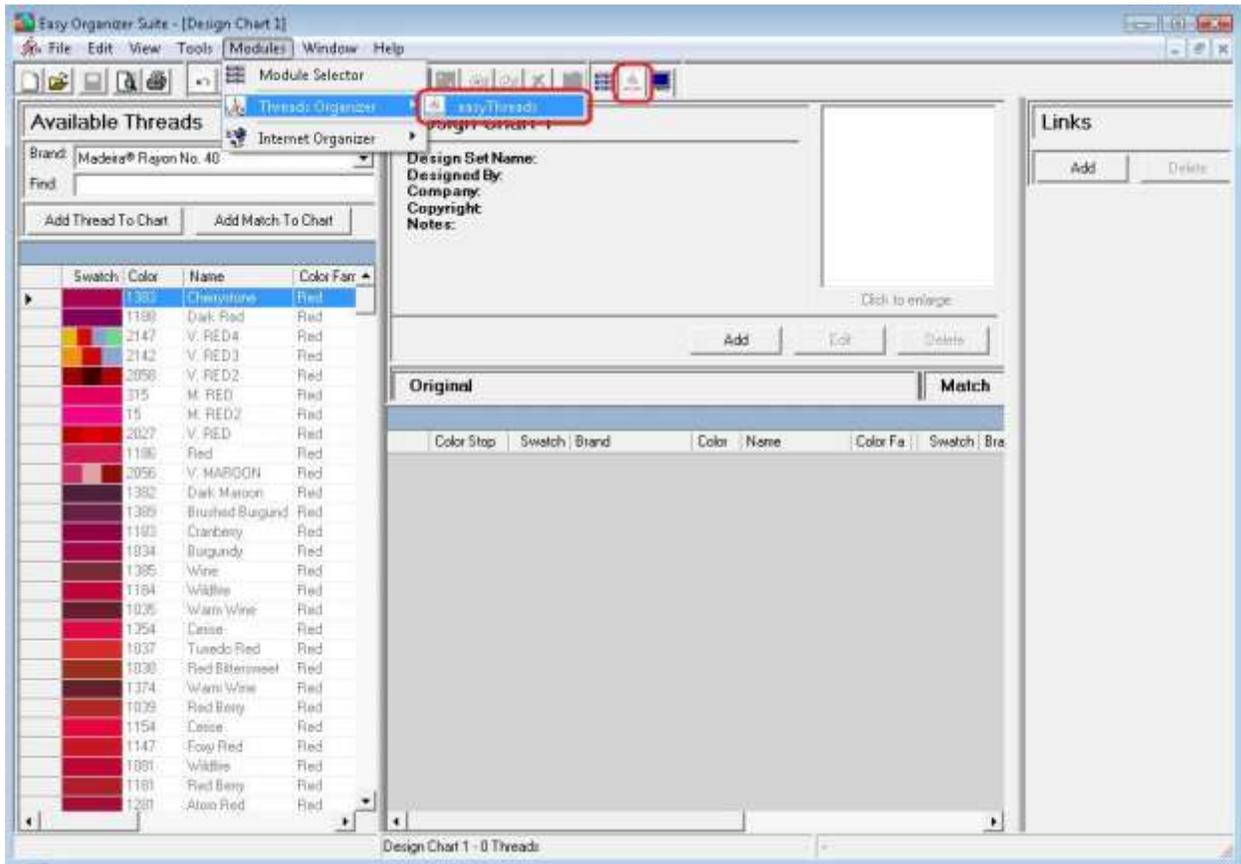
Lesson 24 - How to Import An Exported Design Chart

Welcome to the **easythreads™** Lessons series. 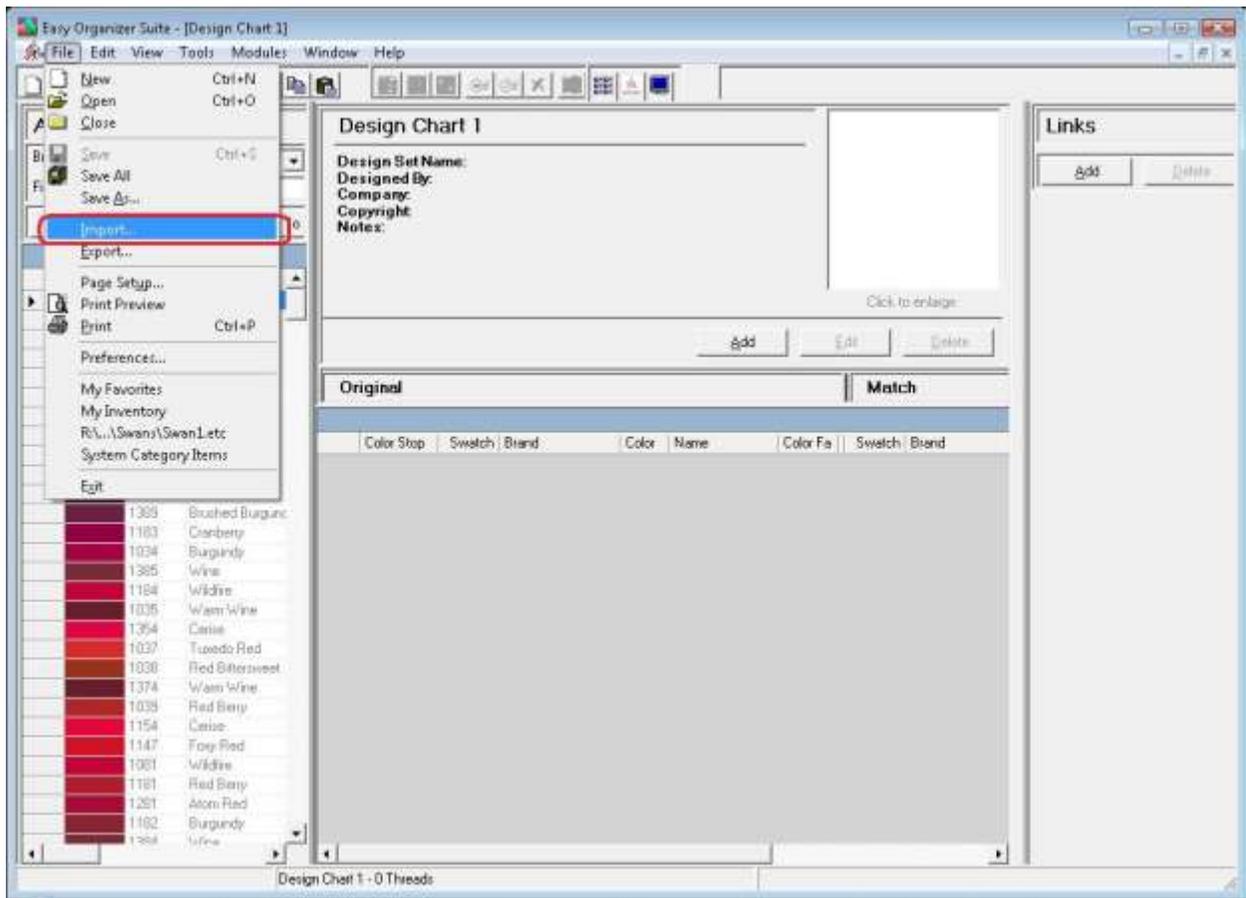
An exported Design Chart can be imported into the **easythreads™** program through the Import Wizard. This feature is only available in the Pro Edition.

Importing An Exported Design Chart

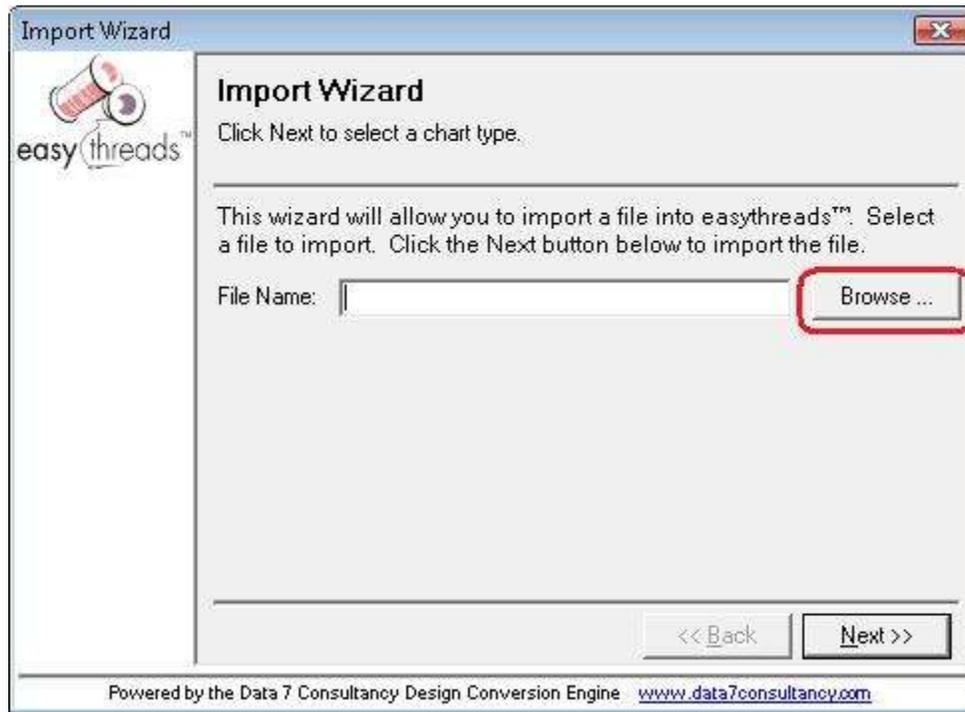
1. To begin, open **Easy Organizer Suite™** and select the **easythreads™** Module. If you are not already in the **easythreads™** Module, then select Modules → Threads Organizer → easythreads from the menu, or you can click on the **easythreads™** icon in the toolbar.



2. To open the Import Wizard, select File → Import.

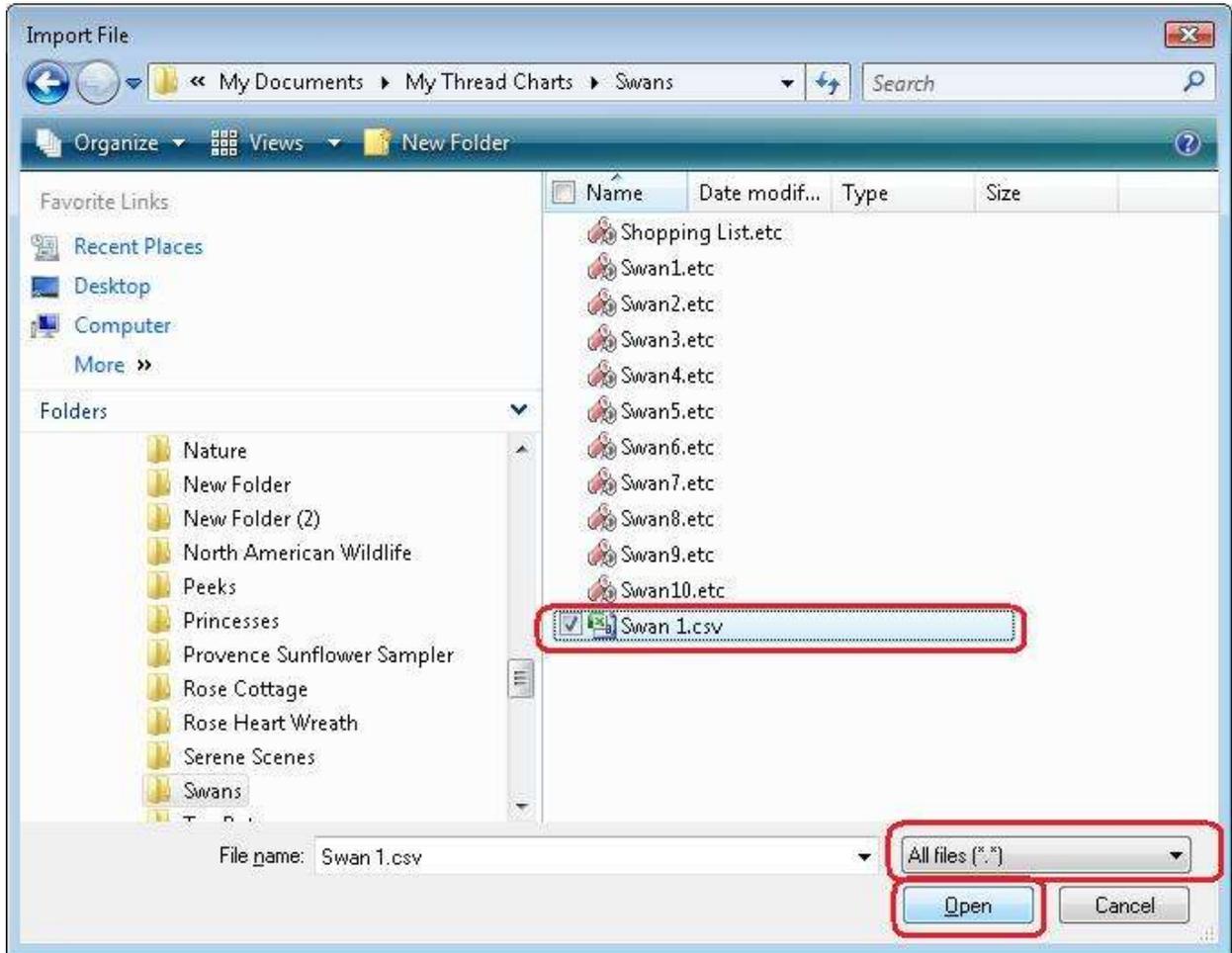


3. The Import Wizard will open. Click on the Browse... button to find the file of threads you want to import.

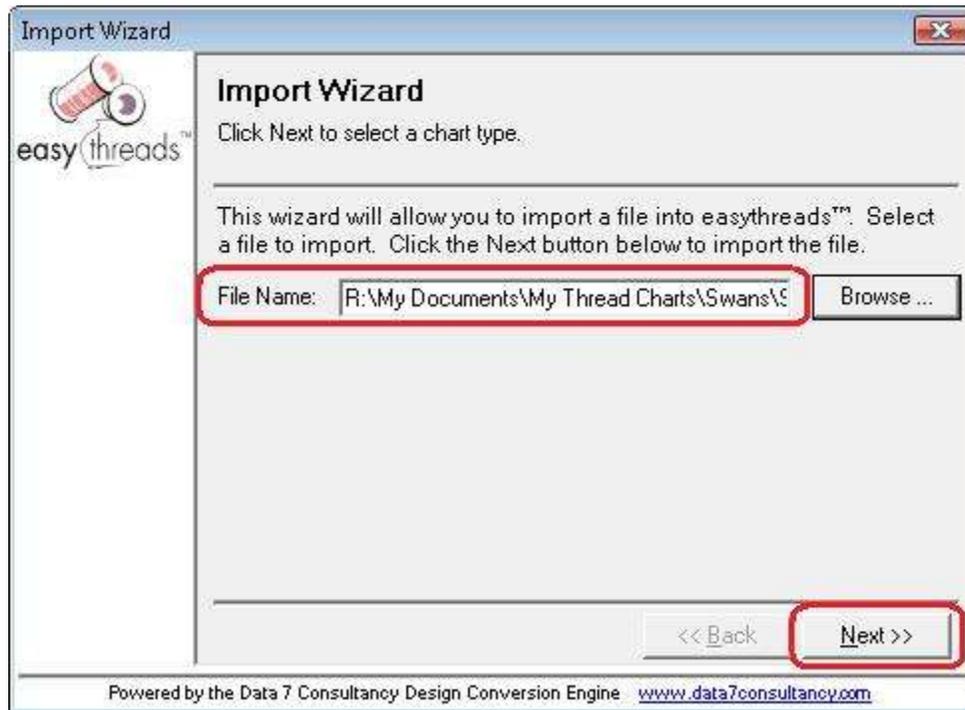


4. The Import File dialog will open. Find the exported Design Chart you want to import and click on the Open button.

For this lesson, we'll import the Design Chart that was exported in Lesson 17 – How to Export a Design Chart. You will need to select either Comma Separated Values or All Files in the File Type dropdown to see the file in the Import File Dialog. Select the file and click the Open button to continue.

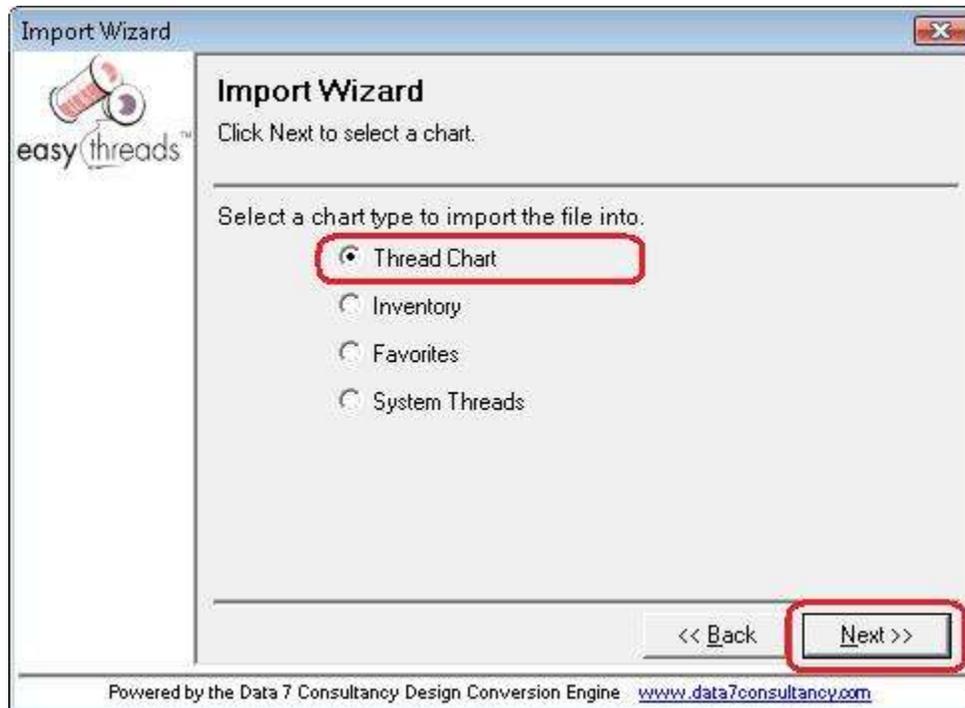


5. The system will put the file path and name in the File Name textbox. Click the Next >> button to continue.



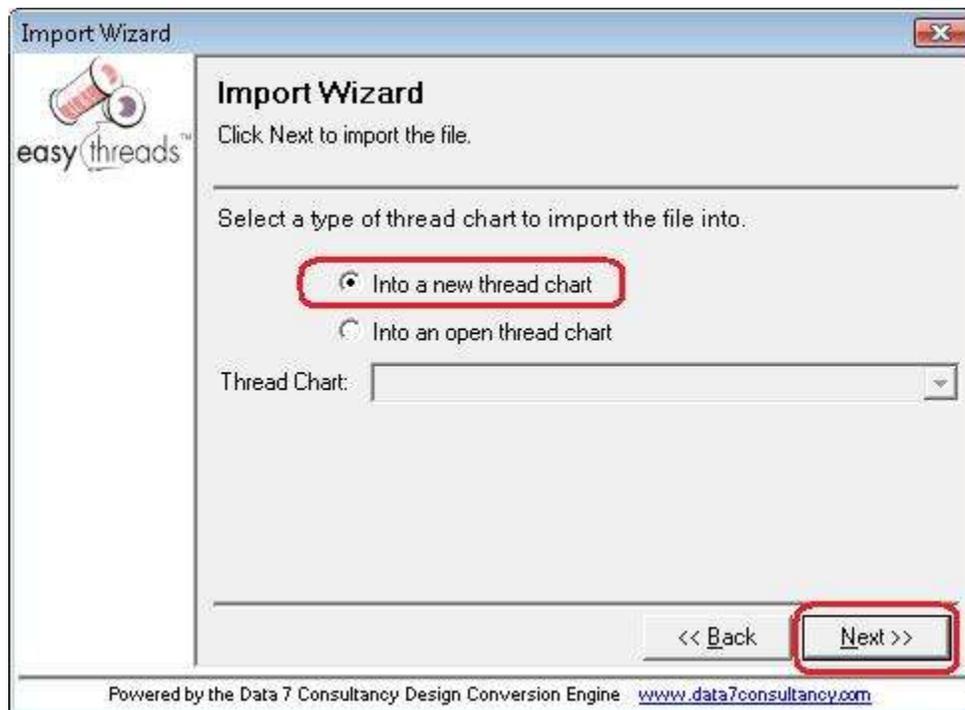
6. The Import Wizard will allow you to import the file into either a Thread Chart, Favorites, Favorites, or System Threads.

For this lesson, let's select Thread Chart. Then click the Next >> button to continue.



7. The Import Wizard will allow you to import the exported Design Chart into a new Design Chart, or an open Design Chart.

For this lesson, let's select a new Design Chart. Click the Next >> button to continue.

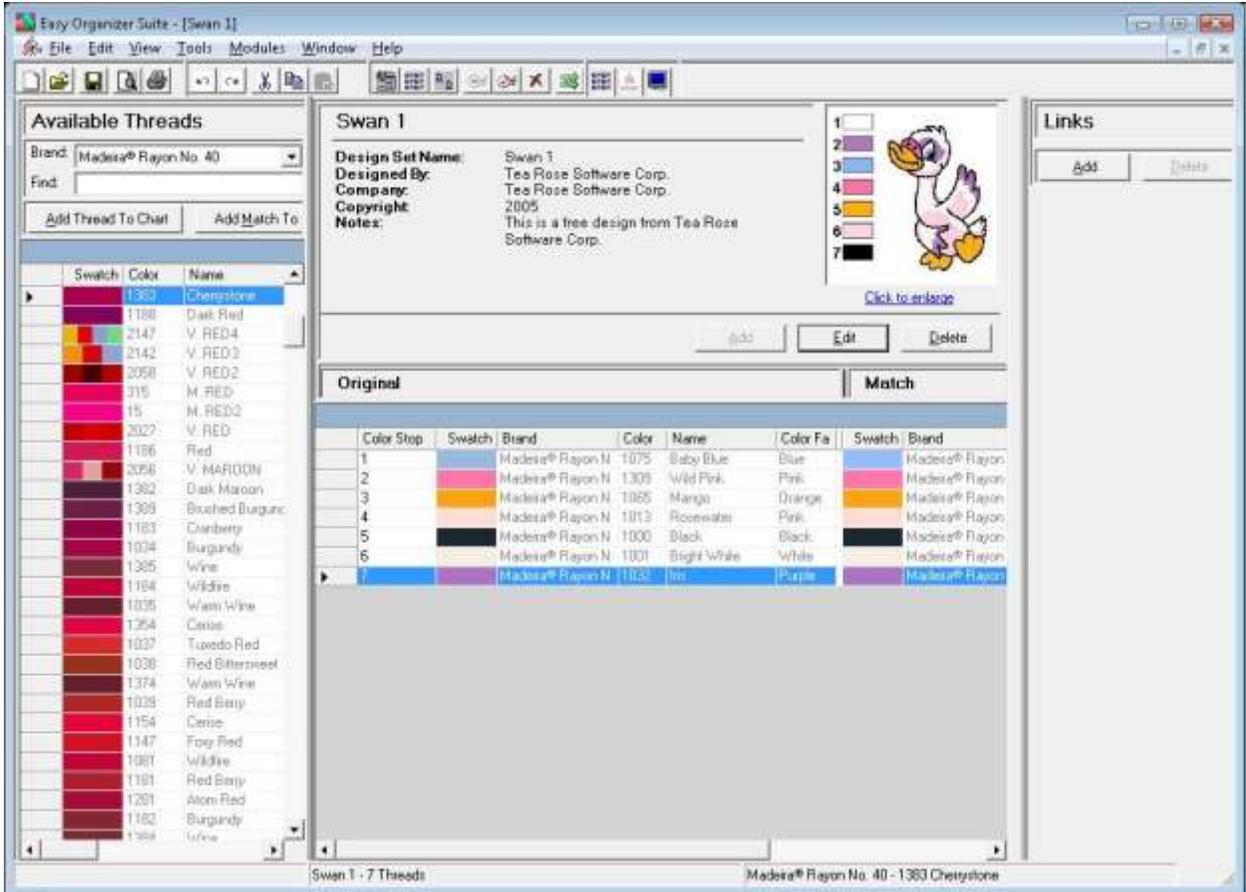


8. The system will now import the exported Design Chart file. It will let you know as it is importing each thread.



- When the Import Wizard has completed, it will close and you will see the imported Design Chart.

You can now save the Design Chart and print it out to begin stitching.
